Environment - Synthetic Turf - Chain of Custody

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment to establish a system to 4 track the chain of custody of synthetic turf installed on sports and playing fields in 5 the State; requiring the custodian of a synthetic turf sports or playing field installed 6 in the State to report chain of custody information to the Department beginning on 7 a certain date on or before a certain date or within a certain amount of time after the 8 completion of the installation, whichever is later; requiring the Department to serve 9 as the custodian for chain of custody information submitted under this Act and 10 develop and maintain a website that includes certain chain of custody information; and generally relating to synthetic turf. 11
