- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) FOR EACH MEETING OF THE BOARD HELD ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1,

- 20 AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC, INCLUDING ANY UPDATES TO THE AGENDA, THE BOARD
- 21 SHALL ALLOW MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO ELECTRONICALLY SUBMIT PUBLIC
- 22 COMMENTS ON AGENDA ITEMS.

- 1 (B) PUBLIC COMMENTS SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS 2 SECTION OR THAT ARE OTHERWISE RECEIVED BY THE BOARD BY ELECTRONIC OR 3 REGULAR MAIL AND RELATE TO A BOARD AGENDA ITEM SHALL:
- 4 (1) BE INCLUDED IN EACH MEETING PACKET PREPARED FOR 5 MEMBERS OF THE BOARD;
- 6 (2) BE POSTED ONLINE AT LEAST 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF THE 7 MEETING, OR AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE AFTER THE PUBLIC COMMENT IS RECEIVED; 8 AND
- 9 (3) BE RETAINED ONLINE THROUGH THE BOARD'S PUBLIC WEBSITE.
- 10 (C) ANY BOARD DISCUSSION ITEMS THAT ARE NOT SUBJECT TO INCLUSION 11 IN A PUBLIC AGENDA UNDER § 3–302.1 OF THE GENERAL PROVISIONS ARTICLE ARE 12 NOT SUBJECT TO PUBLIC COMMENT UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 13 (D) TO CARRY OUT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD SHALL EMPLOY AT LEAST ONE MORE STAFF POSITION THAN THE NUMBER OF POSITIONS AUTHORIZED IN FISCAL YEAR 2023.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
