1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Highway Administration – Vegetation Management – Pollinator Habitat**
3 **Plan**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Highway Administration to develop a certain
5 pollinator habitat plan for the maintenance of vegetated areas along State highways;
6 requiring the Administration to apply for certain federal funding; and generally
7 relating to pollinator–friendly vegetation management.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Transportation**

16 **8–609.4.**

17 **(A) (1) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DEVELOP A POLLINATOR HABITAT**
18 **PLAN, AS REQUIRED UNDER § 2–1801 OF THE AGRICULTURE ARTICLE, FOR THE**
19 **MAINTENANCE OF VEGETATED AREAS ALONG STATE HIGHWAYS.**

1 **(2) IN ADDITION TO THE POLLINATOR HABITAT PLAN, THE**
2 **ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES:**

3 **(I) TO ENCOURAGE THE USE OF POLLINATOR-FRIENDLY**
4 **NATIVE PLANTS ALONG STATE HIGHWAYS;**

5 **(II) FOR REDUCING, TO THE EXTENT FEASIBLE AND IN**
6 **ACCORDANCE WITH RELEVANT SAFETY STANDARDS FOR DRIVERS, BICYCLISTS, AND**
7 **PEDESTRIANS, THE SIZE OF THE AREAS MOWED ALONG STATE HIGHWAYS; AND**

8 **(III) FOR EDUCATING AND COMMUNICATING WITH THE PUBLIC**
9 **ABOUT POLLINATOR-FRIENDLY HABITATS AND MOWING PRACTICES ALONG STATE**
10 **HIGHWAYS.**

11 **(3) THE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR EDUCATING AND**
12 **COMMUNICATING WITH THE PUBLIC UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION**
13 **MAY INCLUDE:**

14 **(I) PLACING AND MAINTAINING, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ANY**
15 **APPLICABLE PROVISIONS IN SUBTITLE 7 OF THIS TITLE, INFORMATIONAL SIGNS**
16 **ALONG STATE HIGHWAYS;**

17 **(II) PUBLISHING INFORMATION ON THE WEBSITE OF THE**
18 **ADMINISTRATION AND SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORMS; AND**

19 **(III) OUTREACH TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC, COMMUNITY**
20 **ASSOCIATIONS, AND ELECTED OFFICIALS.**

21 **(B) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL APPLY FOR FEDERAL FUNDING THAT MAY**
22 **BE USED TO SUPPORT THE USE OF POLLINATOR-FRIENDLY NATIVE PLANTS ALONG**
23 **STATE HIGHWAYS.**

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
25 October 1, 2023.
