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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Criminal Procedure – Crime Solvers Reward Fund – Establishment**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Crime Solvers Reward Fund as a special, nonlapsing  
4 fund in the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to provide grants  
5 to law enforcement agencies and county reward programs to be used as rewards  
6 offered to individuals for certain assistance in solving certain crimes; requiring  
7 interest earnings of the Fund to be credited to the Fund; and generally relating to  
8 the Crime Solvers Reward Fund.

3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
4 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 **Article – Criminal Procedure**

6 **SUBTITLE 12. CRIME SOLVERS REWARD FUND.**

7 **11-1201.**

8 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS  
9 INDICATED.

10 (B) “COUNTY REWARD PROGRAM” MEANS A PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY A  
11 COUNTY THAT OFFERS REWARD MONEY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PROVIDES  
12 QUALIFYING INFORMATION RELEVANT TO THE INVESTIGATION OF A MURDER OR AN  
13 ATTEMPTED MURDER INVOLVING A FIREARM.

14 (C) “FUND” MEANS THE CRIME SOLVERS REWARD FUND.

15 (D) “LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 3-201  
16 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE.

17 (E) “QUALIFYING INFORMATION” MEANS INFORMATION PROVIDED TO A  
18 LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY THAT DIRECTLY LEADS TO THE IDENTIFICATION,  
19 ARREST, AND CONVICTION OF THE PERPETRATOR OF A CRIME.

20 **11-1202.**

21 (A) THERE IS A CRIME SOLVERS REWARD FUND IN THE DEPARTMENT.

22 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO LAW  
23 ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES OR COUNTY REWARD PROGRAMS TO ISSUE REWARDS TO  
24 INDIVIDUALS WHO PROVIDE QUALIFYING INFORMATION TO A LAW ENFORCEMENT  
25 AGENCY RELEVANT TO THE INVESTIGATION OF A MURDER OR AN ATTEMPTED  
26 MURDER INVOLVING A FIREARM.

27 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

28 (D) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT  
29 SUBJECT TO § 7-302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

1           **(2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY,**  
2 **AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.**

3           **(E) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:**

4           **(1) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;**

5           **(2) MONEY MADE AVAILABLE TO THE FUND THROUGH FEDERAL**  
6 **PROGRAMS OR PRIVATE CONTRIBUTIONS;**

7           **(3) INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND; AND**

8           **(4) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR**  
9 **THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.**

10          **(F) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND**  
11 **IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.**

12          **(2) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO**  
13 **THE FUND.**

14          **(G) (1) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY TO AWARD GRANTS TO A LAW**  
15 **ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR A COUNTY REWARD PROGRAM IN ORDER FOR THE LAW**  
16 **ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR THE COUNTY REWARD PROGRAM TO PROVIDE REWARD**  
17 **MONEY TO INDIVIDUALS WHO PROVIDE A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY WITH**  
18 **QUALIFYING INFORMATION RELEVANT TO THE INVESTIGATION OF A MURDER OR AN**  
19 **ATTEMPTED MURDER INVOLVING A FIREARM.**

20          **(2) FOR AN INDIVIDUAL TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A REWARD FROM A LAW**  
21 **ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR A COUNTY REWARD PROGRAM UNDER THIS SUBTITLE,**  
22 **THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR COUNTY REWARD PROGRAM SHALL ESTABLISH**  
23 **THAT THE INDIVIDUAL:**

24                   **(I) PROVIDED CREDIBLE QUALIFYING INFORMATION;**

25                   **(II) DID NOT DIRECTLY PARTICIPATE IN THE CRIME; AND**

26                   **(III) COOPERATED WITH THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.**

27          **(H) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2024, AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE**  
28 **DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH**  
29 **§ 2-1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON:**

1           **(1) THE NUMBER OF REWARDS ISSUED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT**  
2 **AGENCIES AND COUNTY REWARD PROGRAMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE;**  
3 **AND**

4           **(2) THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF MONEY PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.**  
5 **11-1203.**

6           **(A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS**  
7 **SUBTITLE.**

8           **(B) THE REGULATIONS SHALL INCLUDE:**

9           **(1) CRITERIA EXPLAINING HOW ELIGIBLE LAW ENFORCEMENT**  
10 **AGENCIES AND COUNTY REWARD PROGRAMS MAY APPLY FOR FUNDING FROM THE**  
11 **FUND; AND**

12           **(2) CRITERIA FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF AVAILABLE FUNDS IN**  
13 **ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE.**

14                                   **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

15 **6-226.**

16           (a) (2) (i) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and unless  
17 inconsistent with a federal law, grant agreement, or other federal requirement or with the  
18 terms of a gift or settlement agreement, net interest on all State money allocated by the  
19 State Treasurer under this section to special funds or accounts, and otherwise entitled to  
20 receive interest earnings, as accounted for by the Comptroller, shall accrue to the General  
21 Fund of the State.

22                                   (ii) The provisions of subparagraph (i) of this paragraph do not apply  
23 to the following funds:

24                                   170. the Cannabis Public Health Fund; [and]

25                                   171. the Community Reinvestment and Repair Fund; **AND**

26                                   **172. THE CRIME SOLVERS REWARD FUND.**

27           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
28 October 1, 2023.
