4 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class B–HTF (hatchet throwing facility) beer and wine
5 license in Harford County that authorizes certain hatchet throwing facilities to sell
6 beer and wine at retail for on–premises consumption; and generally relating to
7 alcoholic beverages licenses in Harford County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 22–1004.1 of Article – Alcoholic Beverages of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 22–1004.2.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Alcoholic Beverages

22–102.

This title applies only in Harford County.

22–1004.1.

(A) THERE IS A CLASS B–HTF (HATCHET THROWING FACILITY) BEER AND WINE LICENSE.

(B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE FOR USE BY A HATCHET THROWING FACILITY THAT:

(1) IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC; AND

(2) HAS AT LEAST SEVEN HATCHET THROWING PITS.

(C) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO SELL OR SERVE BEER AND WINE AT RETAIL FOR ON–PREMISES CONSUMPTION.

(D) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL OR SERVE BEER AND WINE ON MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY, FROM 8 A.M. TO 2 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY.

(E) THE LICENSE MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER LOCATION.

(F) THE LICENSE HOLDER IS SUBJECT TO THE ALCOHOL AWARENESS TRAINING REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 4–505 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(G) THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL PURCHASE BEER AND WINE FROM ~~A RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER OR~~ AN AUTHORIZED AND LICENSED WHOLESALER ~~OR MANUFACTURER.~~

(H) THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL PROVIDE PREPACKAGED SNACKS FOR PURCHASE AT ALL TIMES WHEN BEER AND WINE ARE SOLD.

1 **(I) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$750.**

2 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
3 1, 2023.
