2 **Maryland Pathway to Nursing Program and Advisory Committee –**
3 **Establishment**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Pathway to Nursing Program in the
5 Maryland Department of Health; requiring the Secretary of Health to establish a
6 certain pilot program before implementing the Program statewide; establishing the
7 Maryland Pathway to Nursing Advisory Committee to assist the Secretary in the
8 development and implementation of the Program; and generally relating to the
9 Maryland Pathway to Nursing Program.

10 BY adding to

11 Article – Health – General

12 Section 13–4801 through 13–4803 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 48.
13 Maryland Pathway to Nursing Program”

14 Annotated Code of Maryland

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Health – General**

5 **(B) "COMMITTEE" MEANS THE MARYLAND PATHWAY TO NURSING**
6 **ADVISORY COMMITTEE.**

7 **(C) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE MARYLAND PATHWAY TO NURSING PROGRAM.**

9 **(A) THERE IS A MARYLAND PATHWAY TO NURSING PROGRAM IN THE**
10 **DEPARTMENT.**

11 **(B) THE GOALS OF THE PROGRAM ARE TO:**

12 **(1) SUPPORT CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANTS IN LICENSED**
13 **PRACTICAL NURSING EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS WHO INTEND TO PRACTICE**
14 **LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING AS A CAREER IN THE STATE OR CONTINUE ON THE**
15 **NURSING EDUCATIONAL PATHWAY TO BECOME A REGISTERED NURSE IN THE STATE;**

16 **(2) ALLEVIATE THE SHORTAGE OF NURSING PROFESSIONALS BY**
17 **INCREASING THE GRADUATION AND LICENSURE RATES OF LICENSED PRACTICAL**
18 **NURSING AND REGISTERED NURSING STUDENTS IN THE STATE;**

19 **(3) INCREASE THE NUMBER OF LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSES AND**
20 **REGISTERED NURSES WHO REFLECT THE DIVERSITY OF THE COMMUNITIES THEY**
21 **SERVE; AND**

22 **(4) PROVIDE PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS WITH FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**
23 **TO COVER THE COST OF:**

24 **(I) TUITION AND RELATED FEES FOR LICENSED PRACTICAL**
25 **NURSING EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS;**

26 **(II) COMPUTERS, TEXTBOOKS, AND OTHER SUPPLIES; AND**

27 **(III) HOUSING, FOOD, AND OTHER BASIC LIVING EXPENSES.**

28 **(C) (1) BEFORE THE SECRETARY IMPLEMENTS THE PROGRAM**
29 **STATEWIDE, THE SECRETARY SHALL IMPLEMENT A PILOT PROGRAM AT COMMUNITY**

1 COLLEGES IN AT LEAST TWO GEOGRAPHICALLY DIVERSE AREAS IN THE STATE THAT
2 OFFER LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING PROGRAMS.

3 (2) THE SECRETARY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE ADVISORY
4 COMMITTEE, SHALL DETERMINE THE FOLLOWING FOR THE PILOT PROGRAM
5 IMPLEMENTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION:

6 (I) THE TIME FRAME AND STEPS NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH
7 THE PILOT PROGRAM;

8 (II) THE AREAS OF THE STATE IN WHICH THE PILOT PROGRAM
9 WILL OPERATE;

10 (III) THE RESOURCES NECESSARY TO SUPPORT THE PILOT
11 PROGRAM; AND

12 (IV) THE TYPES OF EVALUATIONS, INCLUDING OBTAINING
13 FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS AND EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, NEEDED TO MAKE
14 RECOMMENDATIONS ABOUT THE PROGRAM'S DESIGN AND EXPANSION STATEWIDE.

15 (D) THE SECRETARY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE,
16 SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROGRAM THAT INCLUDE:

17 (1) REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM,
18 INCLUDING A REQUIREMENT THAT PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS SIGN AN AGREEMENT
19 THAT THE PARTICIPANT INTENDS TO PRACTICE LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING OR
20 PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSING IN THE STATE FOR AT LEAST 2 YEARS AFTER
21 COMPLETION OF THE PROGRAM;

22 (2) CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE TYPE AND LEVEL OF SUPPORT
23 PROVIDED TO PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS;

24 (3) A PROCESS FOR PROVIDING WRAPAROUND SERVICES TO
25 PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS;

26 (4) A PROCESS FOR DISTRIBUTING FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO
27 PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS;

28 (5) A DESCRIPTION OF THE ROLE OF EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS IN
29 SUPPORTING PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS; AND

30 (6) THE PROCESS FOR PERIODICALLY REVIEWING THE PROGRAM
31 AND IMPLEMENTING MODIFICATIONS TO THE PROGRAM.

1 (E) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 15 EACH YEAR, BEGINNING IN 2023, THE
2 SECRETARY SHALL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH §
3 2-1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE
4 IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAM.

6 (A) THERE IS A MARYLAND PATHWAY TO NURSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

7 (B) THE COMMITTEE SHALL ASSIST THE SECRETARY IN THE DEVELOPMENT
8 AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAM.

9 (C) THE COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS, APPOINTED
10 BY THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH:

11 (1) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS
12 AFFAIRS;

13 (2) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION
14 COMMISSION;

15 (3) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE STATE BOARD OF NURSING;

16 (4) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF
17 LABOR;

18 ~~(4)~~ (5) FOUR REPRESENTATIVES FROM COMMUNITY COLLEGES IN
19 THE STATE THAT OFFER LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING PROGRAMS;

20 ~~(5)~~ (6) TWO REPRESENTATIVES FROM PUBLIC HIGHER EDUCATION
21 INSTITUTIONS WITH A 4-YEAR DEGREE NURSING PROGRAM, ONE OF WHOM SHALL
22 BE FROM A HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY;

23 ~~(6)~~ (7) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM A PRIVATE HIGHER
24 EDUCATION INSTITUTION THAT PRIMARILY OFFERS 4-YEAR DEGREE PROGRAMS;

25 ~~(7)~~ (8) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND NURSES
26 ASSOCIATION;

27 ~~(8)~~ (9) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION
28 OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES;

29 ~~(9)~~ (10) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND INDEPENDENT
30 COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY ASSOCIATION;

1 ~~(10)~~ (11) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND HOSPITAL
2 ASSOCIATION;

3 ~~(11)~~ (12) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE LIFESPAN NETWORK;

4 ~~(12)~~ (13) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE BALTIMORE COUNTY
5 PUBLIC HEALTH PATHWAYS PROGRAM;

6 ~~(13)~~ (14) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM A LABOR ORGANIZATION
7 THAT REPRESENTS CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANTS, LICENSED PRACTICAL
8 NURSES, AND REGISTERED NURSES;

9 ~~(14)~~ (15) TWO PRACTICAL NURSING STUDENTS LICENSED IN THE
10 STATE; AND

11 ~~(15)~~ (16) ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL WITH EXPERTISE OR EXPERIENCE
12 THAT THE SECRETARY DETERMINES IS RELEVANT TO THE COMMITTEE.

13 (D) THE SECRETARY SHALL DESIGNATE THE CHAIR OF THE COMMITTEE.

14 (E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE STAFF FOR THE COMMITTEE.

15 (F) A MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE:

16 (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE
17 COMMITTEE; BUT

18 (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE
19 STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 1,
21 2024, the Maryland Pathway to Nursing Advisory Committee established under Section 1
22 of this Act shall study whether licensed practical nursing education programs that meet
23 educational program requirements under Title 8 of the Health Occupations Article may be
24 eligible for federal and State funding related to apprenticeship programs and report its
25 findings and any recommendations to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health
26 and Government Operations Committee, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State
27 Government Article.

28 SECTION ~~2~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
29 June 1, 2023.
