BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Agriculture

- 23 Number (PIN) shall be created in the Department of Agriculture for the State Ombudsman
- 24 Specialist for Value–Added Agriculture.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, during the first year after
- 26 the initial appointment of the State Ombudsman Specialist for Value-Added Agriculture,
- 27 the priority function of the Ombudsman Specialist is to focus on implementing the
- 28 recommendations of the Task Force to Study the Feasibility of Return to State Meat Process
- 29 Inspection.
- 30 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 31 October 1, 2023.
