3 **Actions and Procedures**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners to ~~deny a license~~
5 ~~to an applicant or take certain action against a licensee for failure to follow an order~~
6 ~~of the Board~~ take disciplinary action against an applicant or a licensee for failing to
7 comply with a Board order; authorizing the Board to grant a stay of enforcement of
8 a Board order in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act; prohibiting a
9 ~~Board order~~ an order of the Board from being stayed pending judicial review;
10 authorizing the Board to appeal a decision that reverses or modifies its order;
11 authorizing the Board to reinstate a suspended or revoked license only ~~under certain~~
12 ~~circumstances; and generally relating to chiropractors~~ in accordance with the terms
13 and conditions of the order of suspension or revocation or an order of reinstatement
14 issued by the Board; and generally relating to disciplinary actions by the State Board
15 of Chiropractic Examiners.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Health Occupations**

14 3–313.

15 Subject to the hearing provisions of § 3–315 of this subtitle, the Board may deny a
16 license to any applicant, reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, with or
17 without conditions, or suspend or revoke a license, or any combination thereof, if the
18 applicant or licensee:

19 (28) Violates any provision of this title; [or]

20 (29) Fails to submit to a criminal history records check in accordance with §
21 3–302.1 of this subtitle; **OR**

22 **(30) FAILS TO COMPLY WITH ANY BOARD ORDER.**

23 3–316.

24 (a) Except as provided in this section for an action under § 3–313 of this subtitle,
25 any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Board in a contested case, as defined in the
26 Administrative Procedure Act, may petition for judicial review as allowed by the
27 Administrative Procedure Act.

28 (b) Any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Board under § 3–313 of this
29 subtitle may not appeal to the Secretary but may take a direct judicial appeal as provided
30 in the Administrative Procedure Act.

31 **(C) (1) THE BOARD MAY GRANT A STAY OF ENFORCEMENT OF A BOARD**
32 **ORDER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.**

1 **(2) AN ORDER OF THE BOARD MAY NOT BE STAYED PENDING**
2 **JUDICIAL REVIEW.**

3 **(D) THE BOARD MAY APPEAL ~~ANY~~ A DECISION THAT REVERSES OR**
4 **MODIFIES ITS ORDER.**

6 **IF A LICENSE HAS BEEN SUSPENDED OR REVOKED UNDER § 3-313 OF THIS**
7 **SUBTITLE, THE BOARD MAY REINSTATE THE LICENSE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH:**

8 **(1) THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE ORDER OF SUSPENSION OR**
9 **REVOCATION; OR**

10 **(2) AN ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT ISSUED BY THE BOARD.**

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2023.
