A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Health Occupations – State Board of Chiropractic Examiners – Disciplinary**
3 **Actions and Procedures**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners to deny a license
5 to an applicant or take certain action against a licensee for failure to follow an order
6 of the Board; prohibiting a Board order from being stayed pending judicial review;
7 authorizing the Board to appeal a decision that reverses or modifies its order;
8 authorizing the Board to reinstate a suspended or revoked license only under certain
9 circumstances; and generally relating to chiropractors.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article – Health Occupations**

23 3–313.

24 Subject to the hearing provisions of § 3–315 of this subtitle, the Board may deny a
25 license to any applicant, reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, with or

1 without conditions, or suspend or revoke a license, or any combination thereof, if the
2 applicant or licensee:

3 (28) Violates any provision of this title; [or]

4 (29) Fails to submit to a criminal history records check in accordance with §
5 3–302.1 of this subtitle; **OR**

6 **(30) FAILS TO COMPLY WITH ANY BOARD ORDER.**

8 (a) Except as provided in this section for an action under § 3–313 of this subtitle,
9 any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Board in a contested case, as defined in the
10 Administrative Procedure Act, may petition for judicial review as allowed by the
11 Administrative Procedure Act.

12 (b) Any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Board under § 3–313 of this
13 subtitle may not appeal to the Secretary but may take a direct judicial appeal as provided
14 in the Administrative Procedure Act.

15 **(C) AN ORDER OF THE BOARD MAY NOT BE STAYED PENDING JUDICIAL**
16 **REVIEW.**

17 **(D) THE BOARD MAY APPEAL ANY DECISION THAT REVERSES OR MODIFIES**
18 **ITS ORDER.**

20 **IF A LICENSE HAS BEEN SUSPENDED OR REVOKED UNDER § 3–313 OF THIS**
21 **SUBTITLE, THE BOARD MAY REINSTATE THE LICENSE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH:**

22 **(1) THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE ORDER OF SUSPENSION OR**
23 **REVOCAATION; OR**

24 **(2) AN ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT ISSUED BY THE BOARD.**

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 October 1, 2023.
