1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maternal Mortality Review Program – Local Teams – Access to Information and**
3 **Records**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the information to which a local maternal mortality review
5 team is to be provided access on request of the chair of the team; requiring that a
6 local team be provided immediate access to requested information; and generally
7 relating to access to information and records by local maternal mortality review
8 teams.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Health – General**

17 13–1209.

18 On request of the chair of the local team and as necessary to carry out the local team’s
19 purpose and duties, the local team shall be provided:

1 (1) [Access] **IMMEDIATE ACCESS** to all [relevant] information and records
 2 [in accordance with the local team’s data use agreement with the Department],
 3 **INCLUDING INFORMATION ON PRENATAL CARE MAINTAINED BY A HEALTH CARE**
 4 **PROVIDER REGARDING A WOMAN WHOSE DEATH IS BEING REVIEWED BY THE LOCAL**
 5 **TEAM**; and

6 (2) [Access] **IMMEDIATE ACCESS**, to the extent allowed by law, to all
 7 information and records maintained by any State or local government agency, law
 8 enforcement investigative information, medical examiner investigative information, parole
 9 and probation information and records, and information and records of a social services
 10 agency that provided services to a woman whose death is being reviewed by the local team.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 12 October 1, 2023.
