2 **Local School Systems – Student Field Trips – Funding**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to include a certain amount of funding in the  
4 annual budget bill for the State Department of Education to provide grants to local  
5 school systems for expenses related to certain student field trips; and generally  
6 relating to funding for local school systems for student field trips.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Education**

7–132.

**(A) IN THIS SECTION:**

**(1) “MUSEUM OF CULTURAL IMPORT” MEANS A MUSEUM THAT PROVIDES HISTORIC AND SOCIOLOGICAL LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES ON THE HISTORY AND CULTURE OF AN OPPRESSED AND HISTORICALLY UNDERREPRESENTED COMMUNITY, LEAVING ATTENDEES WITH A DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF THE COMMUNITY AND ALL PEOPLE’S SHARED HUMANITY; AND**

**(2) “MUSEUM OF CULTURAL IMPORT” INCLUDES:**

**(I) THE UNITED STATES HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL MUSEUM;**

**(II) THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY AND CULTURE;**

**(III) THE JEWISH MUSEUM OF MARYLAND; AND**

**(IV) THE REGINALD F. LEWIS MUSEUM OF MARYLAND AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY AND CULTURE.**

**(B) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$500,000 FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEMS FOR ANY RELATED EXPENSES FOR STUDENT FIELD TRIPS TO:**

~~**(2) THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY AND CULTURE;**~~

~~**(B) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1 EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR THE PREVIOUS FISCAL YEAR ON:**~~

- 2           ~~(2) THE AMOUNT OF EACH GRANT;~~
- 3           ~~(3) THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS AND THEIR GRADE LEVEL WHO~~  
4 ~~BENEFITED FROM THE GRANT;~~
- 5           ~~(4) THE DESTINATION OF THE FIELD TRIP; AND~~
- 6           ~~(5) THE TYPE OF EXPENSES FOR WHICH THE GRANT WAS USED~~  
7 ~~MUSEUMS OF CULTURAL IMPORT.~~

8           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
9 1, 2023.
