AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after “of” insert “establishing the State share for certain school construction projects that meet certain criteria;”; and after line 21, insert:

“BY adding to

Article - Economic Development

Section 10–650(c)(5)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2018 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 22, insert:

“Article – Economic Development

10–650.

(c) (5) THE STATE SHARE OF ELIGIBLE COSTS FOR PROJECTS SHALL BE 100% IF:

(I) THE PROJECT IS LOCATED IN A COUNTY FOR WHICH THE STATE SHARE FOR SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS IN FISCAL YEAR 2025 IS BELOW 55% AND HAS NOT MORE THAN 60,000 FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT ENROLLMENT IN FALL 2023, AS DEFINED IN § 5–201 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE;

(II) THE ALLOCATION UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS TO BE USED FOR A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL THAT HAS THE HIGHEST RATE OF STUDENTS ELIGIBLE FOR FREE AND REDUCED PRICE MEALS AS COMPARED TO OTHER PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS IN THE SAME COUNTY;

(III) THE PROJECT IS CLASSIFIED AS A MAJOR RENOVATION;
AND

(IV) THE PLANNING AND DESIGN FOR THE PROJECT OCCURS IN FISCAL YEAR 2025 OR 2026.”

On page 8, after line 13, insert:

“(7) one member who represents the trades, appointed by the Maryland State and DC AFL–CIO;”;

and in line 15, strike “(7)” and substitute “(8)”.

On page 9, after line 12, insert:

“SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Interagency Commission on School Construction, on or before December 15, 2024, shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, on the eligibility for school construction funding for artificial intelligence weapon detection systems.”;

and in line 13, strike “5.” and substitute “6.”.
