AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 763  
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, strike “and Sunset”; and strike beginning with “terminating” in line 7 down through “date:” in line 8.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with the first “the” in line 3 down through “15” in line 5 and substitute “25”; in line 8, after “ARTICLE” insert “APPOINTED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE”; strike beginning with the semicolon in line 8 down through “(2)” in line 9; and strike beginning with “one” in line 19 down through the semicolon in line 28.

On page 3, strike beginning with “(9)” in line 6 down through “public” in line 8; strike beginning with “(I)” in line 10 down through “THE” in line 11 and substitute “The”; in line 11, strike “appointed”; in line 12, strike “2023” and substitute “2024”; strike in their entirety lines 13 through 15, inclusive; and in line 16, strike “an appointed” and substitute “A”.

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 16 and 17; in line 20, strike “6-802(b)(1) and (9)” and substitute “6-802(b)”; in lines 24 and 25, in each instance, strike “five” and substitute “six”; in line 25, strike “and”; in line 26, after “2027” insert “; and

(4) seven members in 2028”;

after line 26, insert:

“SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the members serving on the Commission on Hate Crimes Response and Prevention appointed under

§ 6–802(b) of the State Government Article as it existed on May 30, 2024, shall expire on June 1, 2024.”;

in line 27, strike “3.” and substitute “4.”; and in line 28, strike “October” and substitute “June”.
