AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 495
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**Delegate Pasteur**” and substitute “**Baltimore County Delegation**”; in line 3, strike “**Records**” and substitute “**Publishing**”; strike beginning with “establishing” in line 4 down through “requirements” in line 6 and substitute “requiring the Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission to publish the names of the candidates for appointment to the Baltimore County Board of Education on the Commission’s website before interviewing the candidates”; and in line 7, after “public;” insert “requiring certain meetings of the Commission to be held without the public in attendance and recorded, and for the recording to be provided, on request, within a certain period of time for public inspection;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with “**NOTWITHSTANDING**” in line 13 down through “**ARTICLE**” in line 17 and substitute “**BEFORE THE COMMISSION BEGINS INTERVIEWING CANDIDATES FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE COUNTY BOARD, THE COMMISSION SHALL PUBLISH THE NAMES OF ALL THE CANDIDATES ON THE COMMISSION’S WEBSITE**”;

in line 18, after “**(5)**” insert “**(I)**”; in the same line, strike “**A**” and substitute “**EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, A**”; in line 19, strike “**INTERVIEW OF, DELIBERATION ABOUT, OR**”; and after line 20, insert:

“**(II) 1. A MEETING OF THE COMMISSION THAT INVOLVES AN INTERVIEW OF OR A DELIBERATION ABOUT A CANDIDATE FOR APPOINTMENT**”

TO THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE HELD WITHOUT THE PUBLIC IN ATTENDANCE
AND THE MEETING SHALL BE RECORDED.

2. THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE A COPY OF A
MEETING RECORDING FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION WITHIN 48 HOURS AFTER
RECEIVING A REQUEST FOR THE RECORDING.”.
