AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1195
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 10, after “settings;” insert “establishing that certain child care providers and employees are immune from civil liability under certain circumstances for actions related to responding to a child’s anaphylactic reaction;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 15, after “PROTOCOLS” insert “, INCLUDING COMPREHENSIVE GUIDELINES FOR STORAGE AND ADMINISTRATION OF EPINEPHRINE”; in line 16, after “STRATEGIES;” insert “AND”; in line 17, strike “STAFF NOTIFICATION” and substitute “NOTIFICATION”; strike beginning with the semicolon in line 17 down through “WASHING” in line 19 and substitute “TO:”

- (I) STAFF WHO COME INTO CONTACT WITH THE CHILD; AND
- (II) CHILD CARE PROVIDER ADMINISTRATORS”.

On page 3, in line 13, after “PROVIDER” insert “OR AN EMPLOYEE OF A CHILD CARE PROVIDER”; and strike beginning with “MAY” in line 15 down through “LIABLE” in line 16 and substitute “IS IMMUNE FROM CIVIL LIABILITY”.
