AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 757

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**Delegate R. Lewis**” and substitute “**Delegates R. Lewis, Alston, Bagnall, Bhandari, Chisholm, Cullison, Hill, Hutchinson, S. Johnson, Kaiser, Kerr, Kipke, Lopez, Martinez, M. Morgan, Pena-Melnyk, Reilly, Rosenberg, Szeliga, Taveras, White Holland, and Woods**”; and in line 7, after “Physicians;” insert “prohibiting an individual from practicing as a supervised medical graduate for more than a certain period of time;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, in line 11, strike “AND”; in line 12, strike “PRESENCE OF” and substitute “**SAME MEDICAL OFFICE AS**”; in line 13, after “GRADUATE” insert “**; AND**”

**3. IMMEDIATELY AVAILABLE TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE AND GUIDANCE TO THE SUPERVISED MEDICAL GRADUATE FOR THE DURATION OF THE COMPLETION OF A DELEGATED DUTY;**

in line 26, strike “IN” and substitute “**SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION AND IN**”; and after line 28, insert:

**“(3) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT PRACTICE AS A SUPERVISED MEDICAL GRADUATE FOR A PERIOD OF MORE THAN 2 YEARS.**

**(4) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, A DELEGATING PHYSICIAN IS NOT REQUIRED TO BE IN THE PRESENCE OF A PATIENT AND A SUPERVISED MEDICAL GRADUATE DURING THE COMPLETION OF A DELEGATED DUTY.**
