4 FOR the purpose of authorizing out-of-state motor home or recreational trailer dealers to
5 display motor homes and recreational vehicles at vehicle shows ~~in Worcester County~~;
6 *requiring the Department of Commerce to conduct a study on the perceivable impact*
7 *of out-of-state dealers of motor homes or recreational trailers displaying or exhibiting*
8 *at vehicle shows in the State on the Maryland RV Show at the Maryland State*
9 *Fairgrounds in Timonium and to report its findings to the General Assembly, on or*
10 *before a certain date*; and generally relating to motor home and recreational trailer
11 shows ~~in Worcester County~~.

3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
4 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 **Article – Transportation**

7 **(G) ~~(1)~~ ~~THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN WORCESTER COUNTY.~~**

8 **~~(2)~~ AN OUT-OF-STATE DEALER OF MOTOR HOMES OR RECREATIONAL**

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That ~~this Act shall take effect~~
16 ~~October 1, 2024:~~

17 *(a) On or after October 1, 2026, the Department of Commerce shall conduct a study*
18 *to determine the perceivable impact of out-of-state dealers of motor homes or recreational*
19 *trailers displaying or exhibiting at vehicle shows in the State at the Maryland RV Show at*
20 *the Maryland State Fairgrounds in Timonium.*

21 *(b) On or before December 1, 2026, the Department of Commerce shall report the*
22 *findings of the study conducted under subsection (a) of this section, in accordance with §*
23 *2–1257 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly.*

24 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect**
25 **October 1, 2024. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and 8 months and, at the**
26 **end of May 31, 2027, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall**
27 **be abrogated and of no further force and effect.**
