4 FOR the purpose of adding the Maryland Community Health Resources Commission to the
5 governmental activities and units subject to the Maryland Program Evaluation Act;
6 extending the termination date for certain provisions of law related to the
7 Commission; ~~stating that it is the intent of the General Assembly that the Office of~~
8 ~~Program Evaluation and Government Accountability in the Department of~~
9 ~~Legislative Services conduct an evaluation of the Commission on or before a certain~~
10 ~~date;~~ and generally relating to the Maryland Community Health Resources
11 Commission.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That Section(s) 8–403(13) through (64) of Article – State Government of the Annotated
22 Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 8–403(14) through (65), respectively.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read
24 as follows:

25 **Article – Health – General**

26 19–2102.

27 (a) There is a Maryland Community Health Resources Commission.

28 (b) The Commission is an independent commission that operates within the
29 Department.

30 (c) The purpose of the Commission is to increase access to health care through
31 community health resources.

32 **Article – State Government**

33 8–403.

34 This subtitle applies only to the following governmental activities and units:

5 SECTION 14. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to Section 13 of this
6 Act, this Act shall take effect July 1, 2005. Section 3 of this Act shall remain effective for a
7 period of [20] ~~23~~ 30 years and, at the end of June 30, [2025] ~~2028~~ 2035, with no further
8 action required by the General Assembly, Section 3 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no
9 further force and effect. Section 5 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of 2 years
10 and, at the end of June 30, 2007, with no further action required by the General Assembly,
11 Section 5 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

13 ~~Assembly that, on or before January 1, 2025, the Office of Program Evaluation and~~
