10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
11 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article – State Government**

13 [18–106.

14 It is unlawful for any notary public to sign and issue any protest except in the form
15 prescribed by the Comptroller.]

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
17 1, 2024.
