A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Gaming – Acceptance of Credit as Payment**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain fire, rescue, and ambulance organizations
4 conducting certain gaming events in Frederick County to accept credit from a person
5 as payment to play a gaming device at the gaming event; and generally relating to
6 accepting credit as payment to play a gaming device.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Criminal Law**

20 12–108.

21 (a) **THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN ORGANIZATION DESCRIBED**
22 **UNDER § 13–1304(B)(2) OR (3) OF THIS ARTICLE CONDUCTING A GAMING EVENT FOR**
23 **ITS OWN BENEFIT IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 13–1304 OF THIS ARTICLE.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(B)** An organization that operates a gaming event authorized under this subtitle,
2 Subtitle 2 of this title, or Title 13 of this article may not accept credit from a person to allow
3 that person to play a gaming device at the gaming event.

4 **[(b)] (C)** Subsection **[(a)] (B)** of this section does not prohibit an organization
5 from accepting a token instead of money from a person who has paid the organization
6 money for the use of the token.

7 **[(c)] (D)** An organization that violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor
8 and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or loss of privileges to conduct a
9 gaming event not exceeding 60 days or both.

11 (b) An organization may conduct a gaming event for its own benefit if the
12 organization is:

13 (2) a Frederick County volunteer:

14 (i) fire company;

15 (ii) rescue company; or

16 (iii) ambulance company; or

17 (3) an auxiliary for a Frederick County volunteer:

18 (i) fire company;

19 (ii) rescue company; or

20 (iii) ambulance company.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
22 1, 2024.
