**Montgomery County - Speed Monitoring Systems - Publication of Notice**  
**MC 19-24**

---

This bill repeals (for Montgomery County only) the requirement that a local jurisdiction publish notice of the location of a speed monitoring system (speed camera) in a newspaper of general circulation.

---

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** The bill does not materially affect local finances or operations.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

---

**Analysis**

**Current Law:** Speed monitoring systems must be authorized in a local jurisdiction by the governing body of the jurisdiction (but only after reasonable notice and a public hearing). Before activating a speed monitoring system, a local jurisdiction must publish notice of the location of the speed monitoring system on its website *and* in a newspaper of general circulation in the jurisdiction.
