AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 819

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**and Woods**” and substitute “**Woods, Alston, Bagnall, Bhandari, Chisholm, Cullison, Hutchinson, S. Johnson, Kaiser, Kipke, Lopez, Martinez, M. Morgan, Pena-Melnyk, Reilly, Rosenberg, Ross, Szeliga, Taveras, and Woorman**”; in line 3, strike “establishing a preference program for certain procurements by” and substitute “authorizing”; in line 4, strike “the University System of Maryland,”; in line 5, after the second “College” insert “to establish a certain preference program for certain procurements”; and in line 6, strike “establishing” and substitute “authorizing”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 32 and 33.

On page 3, in lines 1, 3, and 5, in each instance, strike the brackets; in the same lines, strike “**8.**”, “**9.**”, and “**10.**”, respectively; after line 6, insert:

“(II) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (7) OF THIS SUBSECTION, TITLE 14, SUBTITLE 8 OF THIS ARTICLE (“EMPLOYEE STOCK OWNERSHIP PLAN PREFERENCE PROGRAM”) APPLIES TO MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY, ST. MARY’S COLLEGE OF MARYLAND, AND BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY COLLEGE.”;

and in line 7, strike “(ii)” and substitute “**(III)**”.

On page 5, in line 9, strike “**THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND,**”; in line 10, strike the comma; in line 17, strike “**SHALL**” and substitute “**MAY**”; in line 20, strike

“A UNIT SHALL AWARD” and substitute “IF A UNIT AWARDS”; in the same line, after “CONTRACT” insert “USING COMPETITIVE SEALED BIDS UNDER § 13-103 OF THIS ARTICLE, THE UNIT MAY AWARD THE CONTRACT”; in line 27, strike “A UNIT SHALL AWARD” and substitute “IF A UNIT AWARDS”; and in the same line, after “CONTRACT” insert “USING COMPETITIVE SEALED PROPOSALS UNDER § 13-104 OF THIS ARTICLE, THE UNIT MAY AWARD THE CONTRACT”.

On page 6, in line 19, strike “THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND,”.
