1 WHEREAS, The orange crush cocktail originated in 1995 at the Harborside Bar and
2 Grill in Ocean City, Maryland; now, therefore,

3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
4 That Section(s) 7-313 through 7-319 of Article – General Provisions of the Annotated Code
5 of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7-314 through 7-320, respectively.
