<p>The Humane Society of Harford County, Inc. (HSHC) is a non-profit 501(c)(3) open admission animal shelter, dedicated to the welfare and well-being of the approximately 3,500 animals that come to us in need every year. Founded in 1946, for over 75 years HSHC has provided support for both the pets and people of Harford County, while also advocating for the humane treatment of all animals. We are also the designated animal shelter for Harford County Government, responsible for caring for all animals seized or surrendered via Animal Control. Our Mission The Humane Society of Harford County, Inc. promotes the humane treatment of homeless, stray and abandoned animals by providing shelter, care, adoptions and community education.</p>

This project will provide for construction and outfitting of a new 4,000 square foot training and rehabilitation facility. This innovative facility will maintain a simulated home environment space designed to assist in evaluation of dogs and meet and greets with potential adopters. There will be dedicated behavior space allowing for out-of-kennel enrichment and the facilitation of staff and volunteer training. This building will also provide a much-needed space for community events such as low-cost vaccine and microchip clinics, training classes, networking events, education workshops and additional storage. Specifically, the Bond Bill funds are intended to be used for the purchase and installation of electrical service to the building, HVAC, plumbing, final exterior grading and the construction of a pedestrian access bridge with walkways.
