(Allegany County Delegation)

Finance

Allegany County - Alcoholic Beverages - Minimum Age for Employment of Underage Individuals

This bill increases, from 16 to 18 years, the minimum age an alcoholic beverages licensee in Allegany County may employ an individual if the licensee does not derive more than half of its revenues from the sale of food. A licensee that derives more than half of their revenues from the sale of food may employ an individual between the ages of 16 and 21 years, as specified. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2025.**

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: The bill does not materially affect Allegany County operations or finances.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

Analysis

Current Law: An alcoholic beverages licensee in Allegany County may employ an individual between the ages of 16 and 21 years. To be allowed to sell or serve beer, light wine, and liquor, an individual must be at least 18 years old.
