On behalf of the Enoch Pratt Free Library, and the all the citizens of Maryland, I respectfully request support of **House Bill 436- Enoch Pratt Library-Operating Hours and Funding**. I am the Chair of the Governmental Relations Taskforce for the MD Association of Public Library Administrators. The resources, expertise and training that all Maryland residents receive from Enoch Pratt Free Library and the State Library Resource Center (SLRC) are invaluable. Since 2016 when the Pratt courageously stayed open during the unrest following the death of Freddy Gray. Since that time, funding from this legislation has enabled Enoch Pratt Library branches to expand their hours to include evenings and weekends.
