

I strongly oppose HB0638,

Once again, The Maryland General Assembly is trying to cover their unwillingness to deal with violent felons by passing laws to restrict Lawful citizens and their access to their lawfully owned firearms.

Whether a lawful citizen possesses a firearm that was manufactured by a large company, or it was crafted by the owner, does not make them any more or less a felon or likely to commit a crime.

This bill is so convoluted, unenforceable, and un-able to be implemented.

This bill lacks any clear indication of what problem (if any) it is trying to solve. And the way it is written with its "Selective enforcement", is ripe to be used as a political "Punishment" tool.
