Bill number: HB 376 - Health Insurance – Diagnostic and Supplemental Examinations for Breast Cancer – Cost-Sharing

Hearing Date: February 16, 2023

Planned Parenthood of Maryland (PPM) supports *House Bill 376 – Health Insurance – Diagnostic and Supplemental Examinations for Breast Cancer – Cost Sharing*. The bill would prohibit insurers from imposing cost-sharing or deductible requirements for diagnostic and supplemental examinations for breast cancer screenings in certain circumstances.

PPM supports this measure because cost could cause some women to delay obtaining diagnostic screenings for breast cancer.¹ While the Affordable Care Act requires insurance plans to cover preventative breast cancer screenings, there can be significant cost-sharing for any follow-up screenings.² Women with abnormal or inconclusive preventative breast cancer screenings should not face cost barriers in obtaining needed follow-up care.
