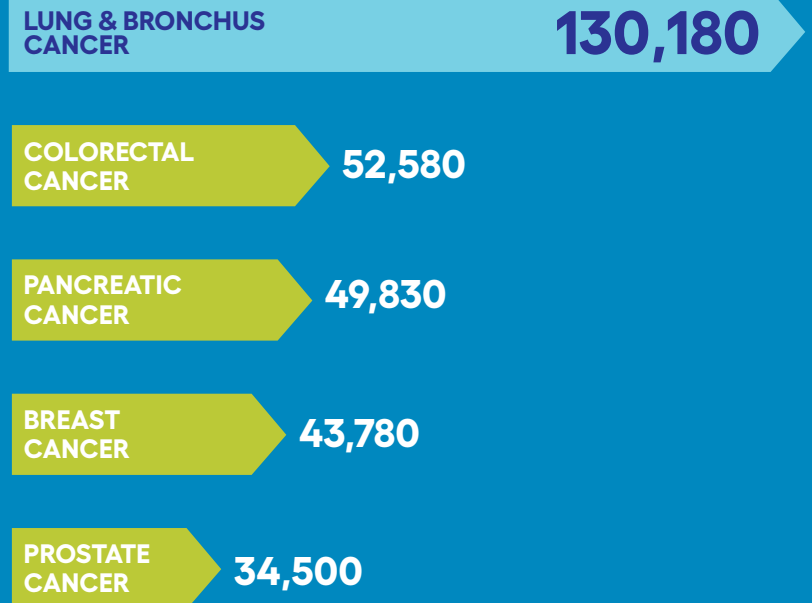


It is estimated that nearly **237,000** Americans will be diagnosed with lung cancer this year.

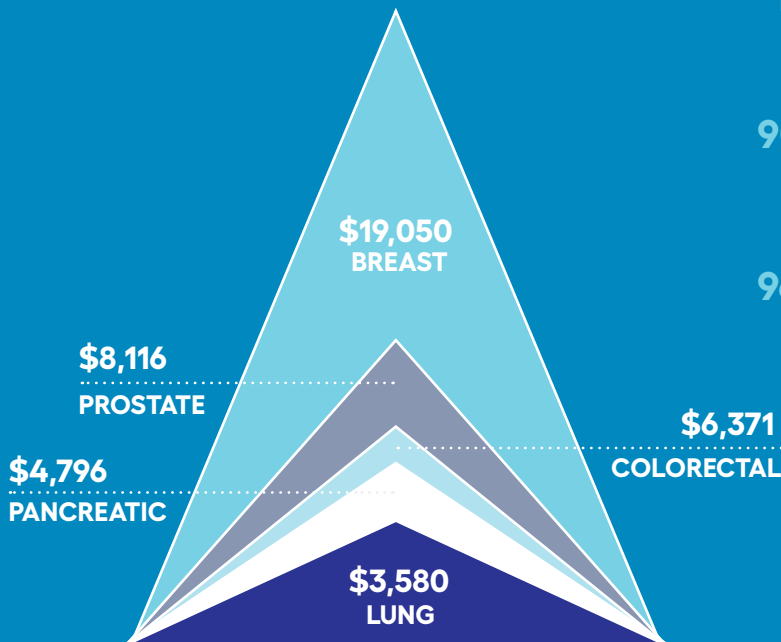
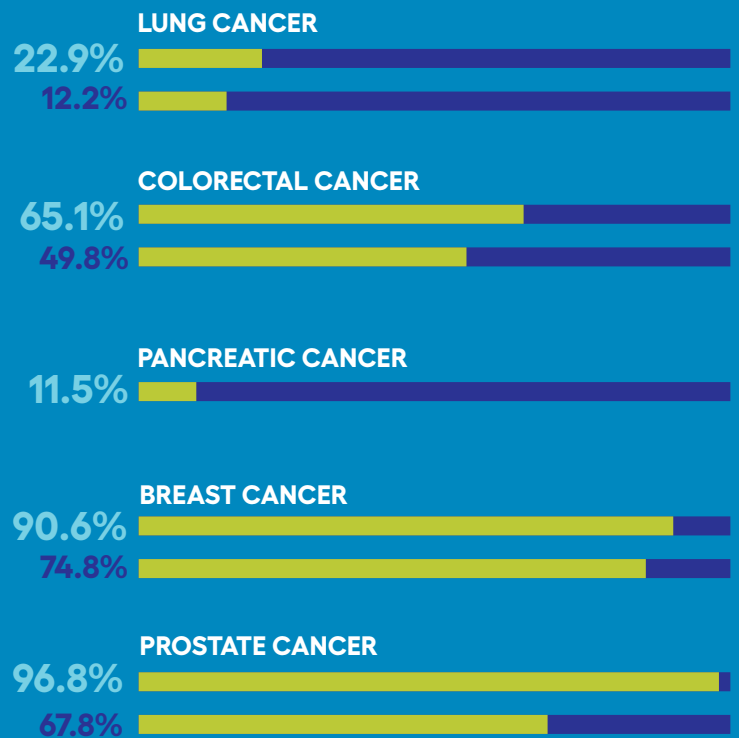
