When we speak of Gold Star families, we are referring to those who have lost a son, daughter, spouse, or close relative in the line of duty. These families bear a profound and heart-wrenching burden, yet they stand resilient, a testament to the strength of the human spirit. The gold star, symbolizing the loss of a family member in service, is a stark reminder of the sacrifices made by these extraordinary families. It is a symbol not only of grief but also of honor and valor. Each gold star represents a life given selflessly for the ideals that define our great nation—freedom, justice, and liberty.

This legislation will go some small way toward honoring and recognizing those lives, and those families who gave the ultimate sacrifice. When a family displays these plates, it improves understanding of their experience and serves as a reminder to the larger community of their sacrifice.
