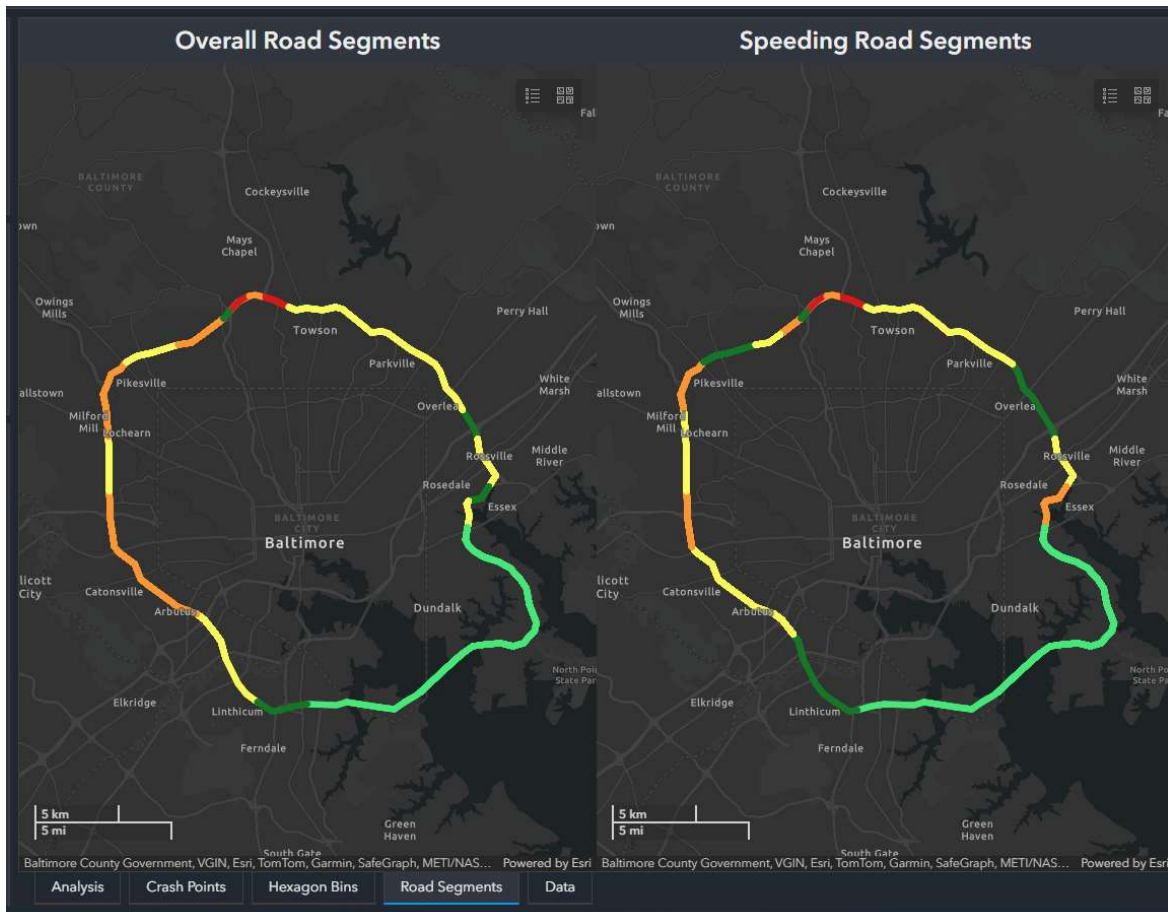


Total crashes (left) and speed related crashes (right). Speed-related is defined as “too fast for conditions” or “exceeding speed limit” as marked on the police crash report. Between 2018 and 2023 there were over 13,000 total crashes and 5,000 speed-related crashes on I-695. The roadway segments with the highest total (left) and speed-related (right) are presented on the maps below. Red, yellow, and orange indicate the segments with the highest number of crashes.
